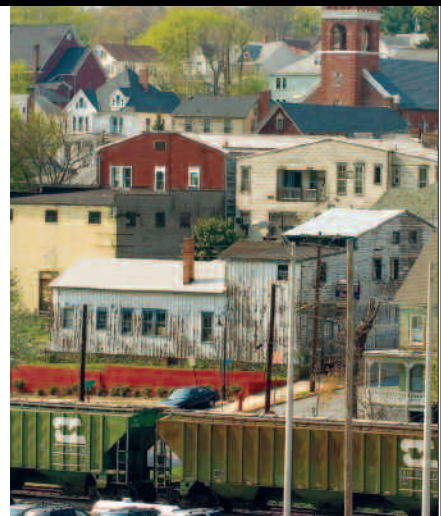
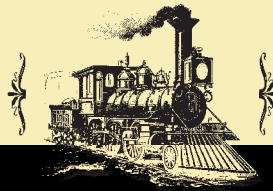
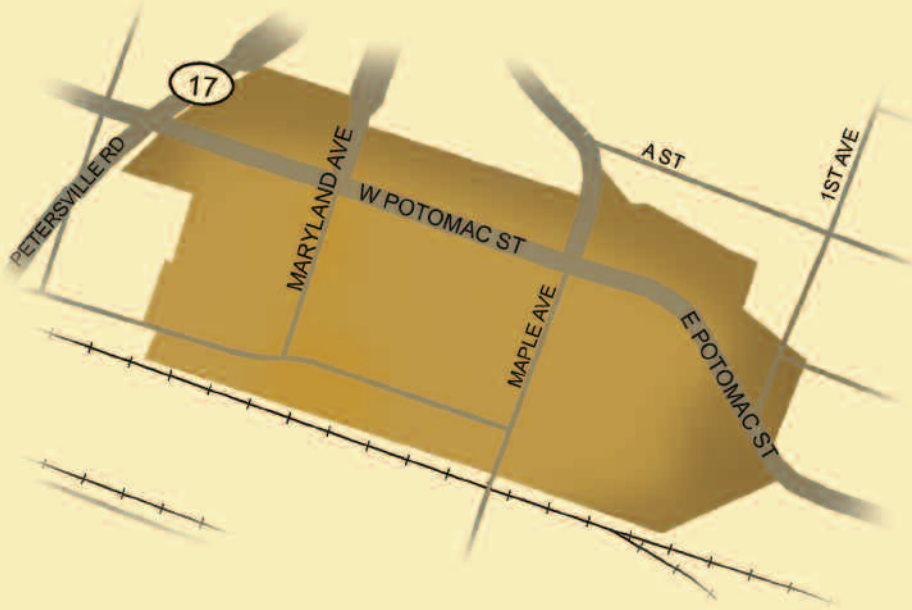


# BRUNSWICK

FREDERICK COUNTY

Nestled in the rising foothills of the Blue Ridge Mountains next to the Potomac River sits the Victorian railroad town of Brunswick. Boasting glorious homes and a bustling city center, Brunswick's population, economy and construction boomed with the B&O Railroad at its doorstep at the turn of the century.

**CONVENIENTLY LOCATED APPROXIMATELY 60 MILES FROM WASHINGTON, D.C., AND BALTIMORE, BRUNSWICK BOASTS GLORIOUS HOMES, A BUSTLING CITY CENTER, SHOPPING, HISTORICAL SITES, A MUSEUM, DINING AND RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES.** The town has a rich history tied to the Potomac River, the C&O Canal and the B&O Railroad. Its heritage has earned the town its place on the National Register of Historic Places as an example of a late 19th and early 20th-century railroad town. The C&O Canal National Historical Park also runs through Brunswick, and the National Park Service operates a C&O Canal Visitors Center downtown. The Brunswick Railroad Museum tells the unique story of the town's history, population, economy and construction boom during the railroad era. It allows visitors to view interpretive exhibits, learn about what railroad life was like for workers at the turn of the century, and enjoy an interactive model railroad layout. Today, historic buildings house new businesses while community events flourish as Brunswick revitalizes and celebrates its history.

Because the Potomac River is only a short walk from the downtown shops, recreational opportunities abound. The waterfront offers fishing, boating, camping, kayaking and canoeing, and the C&O Canal towpath is excellent for hikers, bikers and horseback riders. Picnic areas and a boat ramp into the Potomac are also nearby.

The Victorian railroad town celebrates its heritage through annual festivals, parades and events. During Brunswick Railroad Days in October, visitors can enjoy a variety of street and stage entertainment, crafts, train rides, a model train show, food and activities for all ages. Brunswick also boasts one of the largest Veterans Day Parades in the area. Other events include a river race, holiday festivities and parties and movies in the park.

Brunswick Main Street beckons residents and visitors to "Discover Downtown . . . Again!"
